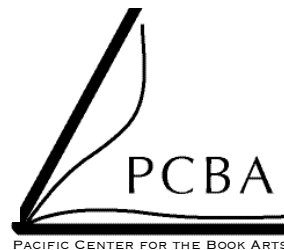


# 2009 Book Arts and Printers' Fair

This is one of the greatest PCBA events of the year—a chance to catch up with PCBA pals, check out what other folks have been working on and pump some money into our vibrant Bay Area book arts economy! This year, we'll have both exhibition rooms again, and will also have the small room where members can sign up to give more in-depth demonstrations or mini-workshops throughout the day.

- We can only accept written reservation requests, accompanied by a check. Tables will be reserved on a first come, first served basis. The deadline is **March 31**, but don't wait, as we usually sell out.
